

2022 Tri-State Challenge Series Points System

The series has established the following system for 2022 under which eligible drivers may accumulate points:

- All Drivers for all Tri State Races will be required to hold a Tri State Membership. If you don't have a Membership the track will withhold your membership from your first series race on your payout.
- In the event the starting driver receives relief during the running of a race, the starting driver will receive the points for that car for the race. The relief driver will not receive any points for driving that car.
- If a driver participates in qualifying but does not race in the main events, the driver will only receive qualifying points.
- Points will go to the driver only. Once the driver qualifies a car, he or she may not change cars.

At the close of the season, the driver with the highest number of ranking points respectively shall be declared the Tri-State Challenge Series champion.

In the case of a tie, Tri-State Challenge Series will determine the champion based on the most first-place finishes. If there is still a tie, we will take 2nd place finishes and so on.

- The fastest qualifying driver will receive 9 points, second fastest will receive 8 points and points awarded will decrease by one-point increments down to ninth fastest (1 point). All drivers qualifying will receive 1 point
- All drivers in the B-Main event not qualifying for the A-main will receive 10 points.
